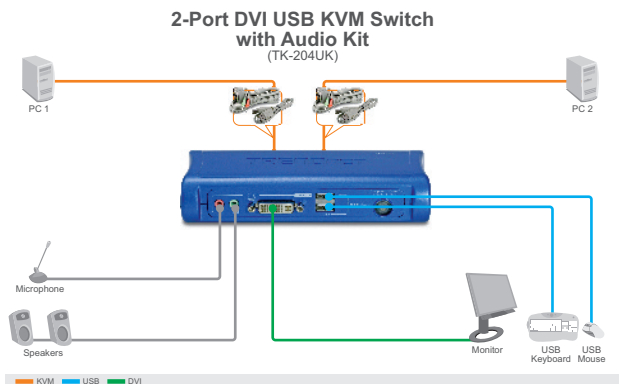

2. Cómo se instala

1. Apague todos los Pcs.

2. Conectar el teclado compartido del USB, el monitor de DVI, el ratón del USB, los altavoces (opcionales) y el micrófono (opcional) con el puerto de consola del interruptor de KVM.

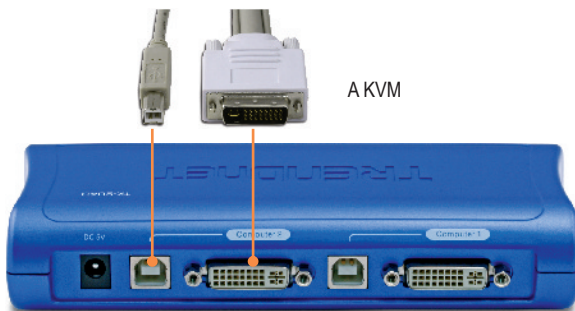


3. Utilice los cables KVM y USB para conectar sus PC al conmutador KVM.

3. Funcionamiento

Nota: Para conmutar entre PCs, puede usar los botones del panel frontal del conmutador KVM, una secuencia de comando de ejecución inmediata “hot-key” vía teclado o la Herramienta del Conmutador Cliente (sólo para Windows).

Botones de arranque

Pulse los botones de arranque para la conexión entre Pcs.

Indicadores LED

LED con luz verde: Computadora 1

LED con luz azul: Computadora 2



Comandos Hotkey

Después de pulsar la tecla ScrLk, dispone de 2 segundos para pulsar la tecla ScrLk otra vez. Ahora dispone de 2 segundos para presionar una tecla de comando. Un pitido confirma que el conmutador KVM está en modo “Hot-Key”. Si usted no pulsa una tecla en el plazo de 2 segundos, el conmutador saldrá del modo hotkey.

Cómo usar un comando Hot Key definido

Cuando utilice el comando a continuación, debe presionar todas las teclas de manera simultánea.



Y representa cualquier símbolo definido en el programa de herramienta KVM. Por defecto, Y = 1 para el puerto 1 y Y = 2 para el puerto 2. Para más información sobre el uso del programa de la herramienta KVM, consulte la sección 4 **Uso de la herramienta KVM**.

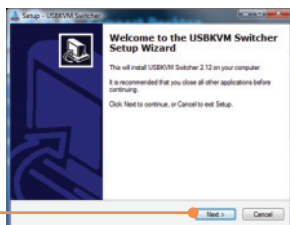
4. Uso de la herramienta KVM

Para los usuarios de Windows

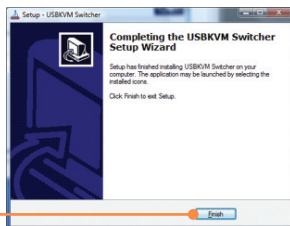
1. Haga clic en **Install Utility**.



2. Haga clic en **Next** (Siguiente).
Luego siga las instrucciones del **Setup Wizard** (Asistente de configuración).



3. Haga clic en **Finish**.



4. Haga doble clic en el icono **KVM Utility** (Herramienta KVM).



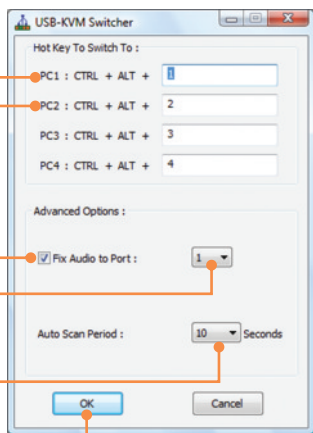
5. Si desea modificar la tecla de ejecución inmediata hot-key, escriba un tipo de dato carácter. Puede introducir cualquier número, letra o símbolo. No podrá usar las teclas de control, tales como Alt, Ctrl, Shift, CAPS LOCK (Bloq Mayús), Tab, Esc, Num Lock (Bloq Núm) y las teclas de función. Por ejemplo: CTRL + ALT + A.

6. Haga clic en la casilla de selección para fijar el Audio a un puerto y luego elija el puerto de la lista desplegable.

7. Seleccione el tiempo de escaneo automático (10~60). Las opciones muestran incrementos de 5 segundos.

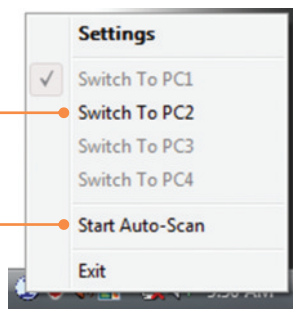
8. Una vez hecho todos los cambios deseados, haga clic en **OK**.

9. Haga clic derecho en el icono de la herramienta KVM en la bandeja del sistema. Si su PC está conectado al puerto del PC 1, deberá ver un icono con el número 1. Si su PC está conectado al PC 2, deberá ver un icono con el número 2.



10. Seleccione el PC y el puerto al que desea conectarse.

11. Haga clic en **Start Auto-Scan** para iniciar el escaneo automático. Haga clic derecho en el icono de la herramienta KVM y seleccione **Stop Auto-Scan** para interrumpir el escaneo automático.

Q1: Do I need to use the included external AC adapter?

A1: You must use the included external AC adapter with the TK-204UK KVM switch.

Q2: I have the KVM switch connected properly, but my keyboard and mouse don't work. What should I do?

A2: First, make sure the power adapter is plugged into your KVM switch. Second, make sure your USB ports are working properly by connecting your mouse and keyboard directly to the USB port computer. Third, once you confirm that the USB ports are functional, please reboot your computers, and try to use the KVM switch again. Fourth, if your computer is running Windows 98SE, you may need to download and install the USB hot fix. Please go to this link for download and installation instructions: <http://support.microsoft.com/kb/q240075>. Once the hot fix is installed, follow the installation instructions in Section 2.

Q3: Can I connect or disconnect the KVM cables while the computers are turned on?

A3: Yes, you can connect or disconnect the KVM cables while the computers are turned on, because the interface is Hot-Pluggable.

Q4: Will the KVM switch restore the keyboard settings between computers?

A4: Yes, the KVM switch will restore the keyboard settings when switching between computers. (i.e.: Caps Lock, Num Lock, etc.)

Q5: How do I switch from one computer to another with the KVM switch?

A5: You can switch computers by pressing the Push Buttons on the KVM switch or using the Hot Key commands. Go to Section 3 Operation for more information.
